COVID-19 Protocols & Guidelines.

Sunday 7th July 2020

We have today been inspected & given the go ahead to resume charters from the Central Board of Health in Antigua.

However, we now have a new set of guidelines that we all have to follow in order to us all to stay safe and well from COVID-19

Please read the below information – this is to be adhered too at all times For those of you that are repeat guests of ours – things will now be a little different than perhaps what you are used too in regards to the closeness and intimacy of our charter – however the aim is for us to still make it as special a day as possible for all our guests new and returning

We have for the time being reduced the maximum capacity on board Catch the Cat to 6 so we are able to ensure social distancing practices

We are also only offering the 6 & 8 hour charter currently as there are now many additional cleaning protocols we need to go through each day prior to and after each charter which will not allow adequate cleaning times between the 4 hour charter and the Sunset Cruise

For our Guests:

- Prior to boarding the vessel, you will be required to wash your hands with soap & water that will be provided by CTC
- All guests are required to complete temperature screening before boarding and throughout the day
- Shoes will be placed by you in a sealed container which will be stored away until the end of the day and feet will be sprayed with 70% alcohol prior to boarding
- Throughout the day you will be encouraged to wash your hands frequently there are also sanitization stations throughout the boat
- The use of masks, sunglasses, specs or visors are to be worn by guests during tours but not while swimming, snorkeling or diving, or when sufficiently distanced.
- PLEASE ENSURE YOU BRING YOUR OWN MASKS WITH YOU
- For health & safety purposes we strongly advise you bring your own snorkeling equipment
- We provide YETI cups which are color coded for individual use you will be ask ed to keep your cup for the day
- We also ask that you maintain a 6ft distance from the Captain & Hostess at all times for everyone's safety
- PLEASE ENSURE THAT YOU BRING YOUR OWN TOWELS WE DO NOT PROVIDE THEM
- We can for the moment carry a maximum of 6 guests on board.
- PLEASE NOTE THAT NO MIXED GROUPS ARE ALLOWED FOR CHARTER ONLY FAMILIES, COUPLES, FRIENDS & RELATIVES THAT HAVE TRAVELLED TO ANTIGUA TOGETHER – NOT OTHER PEOPLE THAT YOU MAY HAVE MET WHILST IN RESORT.

For the Boat:

- Catch the Cat will ensure that the vessel and all equipment are kept clean and sanitized before, during and after each passenger trip using chemicals identified as effective against the SARS-CoV-2 virus as approved by Health Authorities.
- We have installed adequate signage and other physical demarcations at various points showing sanitization stations.
- We will be washing our hands frequently throughout the day.
- We have provided passengers with access to hand sanitizers at various points throughout the vessel
- Toilets will be disinfected after each use.
- Physical distancing rules will be strictly adhered too, and appropriate face covering utilized in instances where physical distancing is unlikely.
- We have installed a PA system, so we are able to communicate and tell you about all the sights of the island whilst maintaining social distancing.
- Handrails and other high touch surfaces will be frequently sanitized with an alcohol-based sanitizer or other approved disinfectant.
